# **President's Report**

2010 was a great year for Kedron Wavell Services Hockey Club. Our Club continued its strength in terms of numbers of teams playing under the Kedron Wavell Services Hockey Club banner. The following section reports will detail the teams playing this year and their performances.

Our Club members and supporters continued to provide their much valued support for the Club and its players. Without this support we would not be able to benefit from the canteen at Burringbar Park, a benefit which would be much valued by other clubs, the financial support from our major sponsor, Kedron Wavell Services Club, and, being able to complete the many tasks which must be undertaken to put our teams on the field. To all those supporters who voluntarily gave up a lot of their time I would like to extend a very big THANK YOU from both myself, the Management Committee and the many players who reap the final benefit from all our efforts – the ability to play hockey!

#### **Burringbar Park**

Kedron Wavell continued to work with BHA and BWHA to ensure a quality facility for our sport is maintained and to ensure it remains the **Home of Kedron Wavell Hockey**.

BHMG decided to maintain our running of the canteen with a new profit share arrangement so that the canteen meets its costs and makes a contribution towards the running and development of Burringbar Park. We negotiated with BHMG to ensure our Club members received a reasonable return for the considerable effort they put in to running the canteen.

Demands for the use of the turf field are growing especially from Northside Clubs. Your Management Committee has been able to preserve the number of training hours on Wednesday nights but some junior training with an early start was required to accommodate other clubs using the field. The division of training times by BHMG was equitable amongst all clubs but it was a difficult task given the lack of facilities on the northside. Until there are a larger number of artificial surfaces in Brisbane the availability of training times will remain limited and our Club will need to be flexible in regards to its training times.

BHMG has taken a decision to replace the surface early in 2011. The cost will be approx. \$300,000. It is hopeful of gaining grants from both the State Government and BCC to finance the replacement. Replacement in early 2011 will have an impact on early training times for turf teams. For next year teams will need to go to other venues or train on grass because the field will not be available for the early part of the year. However, once replaced we will have the best turf available in Brisbane.

As part of the project to replace the turf BHMG will also be holding a working bee to clean up the other components of the facilities at Burringbar Park. I will be calling on our Club members and supporters to attend this part of the project in large numbers to show that we value our home ground and to bring it up to a condition that we can be proud of.

2010 was the second year of our sponsorship arrangements with the Services Club. The Services Club has been a great supporter of our Club for many years and their financial support is very welcome to assist with members costs in playing our great sport and in developing our sport in our local area. # **Treasurer's Report**

The 2010 season has resulted in a deficit of income over expenditure. The following table highlights the significant items contributing to the result. It should be noted that the accounts presented are prepared on a cash basis.

Over all, player fee expenditure exceeded income by \$16,856 due to outstanding invoices from the 2009 season being paid this year as well as increased coaching, registration and game fees. Income of \$9,580 from the 2010 year six-aside (Oct/Nov 2009) was recorded in the 2009 income statement when it was received. This year the processing of team registration payments was held over until October to align income with the 2011 season.

With the Club wide replacement of uniforms this expense item rose significantly and was partially offset by increased sponsorship and income from items purchased by members. The executive acknowledged the increased expense to members associated with new uniforms and limited fundraising this year to a raffle thanks to Kathy Mehonoshen for her organisation of this event, cake stalls and sausage sizzles.

The canteen result for this year is disappointing. A large amount of effort goes into organising and then operating the canteen. Thanks to each section's canteen roster organiser and the members who complete their roster. A double whammy of decreased takings with increased expenses produced a modest return. The additional expense included \$5,625 relating to last year and it is acknowledged that the Club "lost stock" when freezers broke down or defrosted. The Club was also without the main display fridge when it too broke down and was replaced temporarily with eskies, thanks to those who provided these to the Club, until replaced.

Thanks to all the section treasurers for their efforts during the year.

While the 2010 season shows a deficit of income over expenditure the balance sheet shows net assets of \$61,963 consisting entirely of cash based assets. This asset should serve the Club well going forward.

#### **Annual Report – Girls Section**
