# President's Report

2012 was yet another good year for Kedron Wavell Services Hockey Club, with a great club family thoroughly enjoying our wonderful sport.

As with almost every sporting organisation, we survive, succeed and prosper on four pillars: our players, our organisational personnel, our sponsors and our supporters – meaning family, friends and club stalwarts. As such, in opening my report this year, could I again note, on behalf of all the players of every age that got to enjoy their hockey for another year, my thanks to all of those within our wider club family who gave up your time for us.

Every club section took out its fair share of end-of-season honours, with many individual players gaining representative honours. Australian representative honours at the London Olympics were there as well; with Jodie Schulz not just a beacon for all our club juniors but a star of the Hockeyroos advertising campaign as well. The section reports provide the detail the teams playing this year and their performances, and record individual honours; but I think it is worth me stealing a little of the Vice-President's space in recording the Club's delight when Alyssa Kerr made it back-to-back Best & Fairest awards in the BWA Division 1 competition, and Adam McClelland finished second in the BWA Division 1 Best & Fairest count.

Our breadth of success in the season was highlighted for me on the first Grand Final weekend when, in parallel with our tireless Club patron Mrs Jenny Tidey, I was ricocheting between Downey Park and the State Hockey Centre watching Club teams participate in Grand Finals in Junior Boys, Junior Girls, and Ladies Grass teams – as well as the preliminary final for the Division 1 Ladies.



Following on last year's widespread adoption of the 'Wolves' name and logo, it was this year great to see all the goalie smocks out on the field. This year will see the first 'Grey Wolves' shirts out, as the senior men strike up their club supporters/ fundraisers group for its first full year.

## Our Principal Club Sponsor



2012 was the first year of our new sponsorship arrangements with the Services Club, and I want to again acknowledge the enormous support that is provided to our Hockey Club by Kedron Wavell Services Club.

This year presented some difficulties for the Services Club in continuing sponsorships, as the Federal Government threatened a key source of the discretionary income the Services Club receives that flows on to us. Fortunately, the

Services Club was able to confirm their support for 2012; and I am hopeful that the Services Club will come back again with its support in 2013.

In the interim, please continue to give our namesake sponsor all the support in return that you can.

## Burringbar Park

Kedron Wavell continued to work with BHA and BWA to ensure a quality facility for our sport is maintained at Burringbar Park and to ensure it remains the 'Home of Kedron Wavell Hockey'.

The improved dugouts were welcomed this year, but I am also confident that everyone will appreciate the construction of a new decked viewing area that restores the full view of the field that has temporarily been lost. Kedron Wavell has, through its participation in BHMG, been pushing very hard to get an improvement in the grass fields, which are suffering from overuse in much the same way as many other grass fields in Brisbane.

Your club continues to operate the canteen, including the liquor licence, under the profit share arrangement so that the canteen meets its costs, makes a contribution towards the running of Burringbar Park through BHMG and, most importantly, our Club receives a reasonable return for the considerable effort our members put into running the canteen.

## **Club Management**

The Club's Management Committee and Club Captains did another great job this year (the latter headlined another great Senior Presentation Night at the Services Club), and I want to particularly thank those people who stepped in to fill vacancies which arose during the year. Everyone again rose to meet the challenges, and I am grateful for every bit of work that they put in, and to all of their tireless support volunteers in each of their roles.

### **2012 to 2013 ...**

A highlight for me at the end of season was the great Junior's function at Enoggera Bowls Club. I think the numbers on the night were about 198 attending of 206 playing juniors – and about 100 parents. Everyone had a great evening, and the bowls club were great hosts; and it certainly seemed that the futsal and beach volleyball were thoroughly enjoyed by all the juniors in attendance.

That event also highlighted for me the way in which our supporters, volunteers and parents have got us through many challenges in the past and their continued efforts are the platform of future success.

As such, I again urge you to help the Club with whatever time and resources you can spare. If you are in a business that can look at a sponsorship, then we would love to talk to you as well!

My best wishes to everyone for the holiday season, and see you at the field in 2013!

# Treasurer's Report

This Treasurer's report and the audited Financial Statements that are part of this Annual Report are prepared on a cash accounting basis. 2012 has been a challenging year financially for Kedron Wavell Services Hockey Club Inc. ('The Club'), as during the year both Alan Gough and Kathy Mehonoshen resigned from their positions as Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer respectively. We thank them both for their contributions.

Special thanks must go to Ian Harcla who was able to keep payments being processed to enable our various creditors to be paid during this time. The untimely payment of fees and collection miscellaneous receivables put strain on our cash resources during the year.

In June the Management Committee acknowledged the need for timely and accurate financial statements and a paid Bookkeeper was appointed; this has been a very successful move. Working with the Bookkeeper we have been able to issue the monthly financial statements to the committee at least a week before the committee meetings which enables members to review the financial statements prior to the meeting.

## STATEMENT OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURE

2012 resulted in a small loss of \$838.64 (2011: Loss \$26,687.37); primarily due to the receipt of 1.5 years worth of Kedron Wavell Services Club sponsorship as the second half of the 2011 sponsorship was received in the 2012 financial year.

It must be noted that at year end player registration and game are fees owed to Brisbane Hockey Association; these expenses have not been recognised in the 2012 financials nor has payment been made. At year end The Club is owed \$17,083 in outstanding player registrations relating to seasons 2011 and 2012. The debtors are broken down as follows:

These debtors have not been recognised in the 2012 financial statements as income nor as accounts receivable due to our method of accounting being cash.

The canteen sales were significantly reduced by \$17,849.38 (31% decrease) compared with 2011, unfortunately the declining income trend has occurred for the past two years and the management committee is currently reviewing canteen operations to be able to stop or at least minimise this trend. Canteen cost of goods sold also decreased by \$13,141.74 (29% decrease) which is in line with the income decrease. Overall the canteen returned a small profit of \$2,953 for the year; this figure includes the purchase of a new freezer, deep fryer, small fridge and stainless steel benches which have all been necessary for the ongoing operations of the canteen.

During the year the club purchased a much needed scoreboard for Burringbar Park; this purchase was offset by three sponsors for which we are very grateful.

## BALANCE SHEET

The Net Asset position of the Club at year end is slightly lower than 2011 (2.4% decrease) however as noted earlier The Club still is to make payment to Brisbane Hockey Association and once this payment is agreed and paid The Club's Net Asset position will be significantly worse. Efforts are being made to collect the outstanding debtors previously mentioned and this will have a positive effect on The Club's Net Asset position.

The timely payment of playing fees will be essential for smooth operations in 2013. A central database will be in operation in 2013 for the receipting of player fees and this will ensure that each section of The Club has a clear picture of their player fees collection at all times and will also provide the Management Committee with an overview of these collections.



In closing 2012 has highlighted the importance of timely collection of player fees and the importance of managing the financial operations of The Club. The need for a review of all financial aspects of The Club is needed and has already commenced and the financial performance of 2012 will be front of mind when making financial decisions in the future.
