# **President's Report**

# **Treasurer's Report**

This Treasurer's report and the audited Financial Statements that are part of this Annual Report are prepared on a cash accounting basis.

#### STATEMENT OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURE

2015 resulted in a net profit of \$14,992.87 (2014 profit \$18,472.57) for Kedron Wavell Services Hockey Club "The Club". The 2015 result should be read with the following notes:

- \*As noted in the 2014 Treasurers report the 2014 senior presentation dinner invoice was not paid at year end and was paid in the 2015 financial year hence why the 2015 expenditure appears significantly higher than 2014.
- \*The canteen returned a profit of \$9,357.80 for the year; this is down on 2014 due to decreased revenue (-5.5%).
- \*As at 30 September 2015 (year-end) the following expenses are outstanding and due to the method of accounting being cash are not included in the Statement of Income and Expenditure:
  - Men's registration fees \$8,578.00
  - BHA Annual Dinner \$600.00
  - -Men's coaching payments \$8,000.00

#### **BALANCE SHEET**

Net assets of The Club have again increased in 2015 to \$56,454.39 (36% increase). As noted above the men's section has expenses still to finalise for season 2015 and income to collect to meet this expenditure.

The Club's policy of 30 April deadline for the payment of player fees is crucial for The Club to be able to meet its financial obligations during the season. The Boys, Girls and Women's sections are to be commended on their continual adherence to this policy. Unfortunately the Men's section has not collected their fees in a timely manner and this has resulted in financial commitments not being met on a timely basis.

A special note of thanks must go to Kaaren Lane who has been a section treasurer for the last 10 years for the Boys, Girls and most recently the Women's section. Kaaren is stepping down from these roles but is to be thanked for her support and dedication to The Club.
